

Safety information for visitors/ contractors





## Dear visitor,

Welcome to our Oege site. As a hot rolling operation, we work with hot and heavy materials (steel coils). We care about your safety, so we would like to take this opportunity to draw your attention to a few points. Please read through them and act accordingly while you are here.



### 4. Material, transportation & traffic

Movements by forklifts, cranes, rail vehicles and trucks are commonplace on site. Rail vehicles have priority. German road traffic regulations (StVO) apply throughout. Lights must be kept switched on. Please remain alert, heed the warning signs and follow the instructions of your guide.



### 1. Registration

When you arrive, please report immediately to the plant safety department and wait until your contact comes to meet you. For safety reasons, third parties are not allowed to enter the site unaccompanied.

### 2. Visitor/contractor pass

Please wear the high-visibility vest and attach the visitor pass you are given prominently so that everyone can see that you are entitled to be on site. These items must be handed in again when leaving the site.



### 3. General health and safety regulations

Protect yourself and our employees by observing our health and safety regulations. Please wear the required personal protective equipment such as safety helmets, protective footwear, ear protectors, etc. and keep to the marked visitor paths. Should you be visiting our site as part of a group, please stay together. The carrying and consumption of alcohol and other stimulants is strictly forbidden in all areas. Please follow the instructions provided by your guide.





# 5. Health risks

As we also work with magnetic cranes, anyone with a pacemaker or other implanted device should avoid the marked areas.
